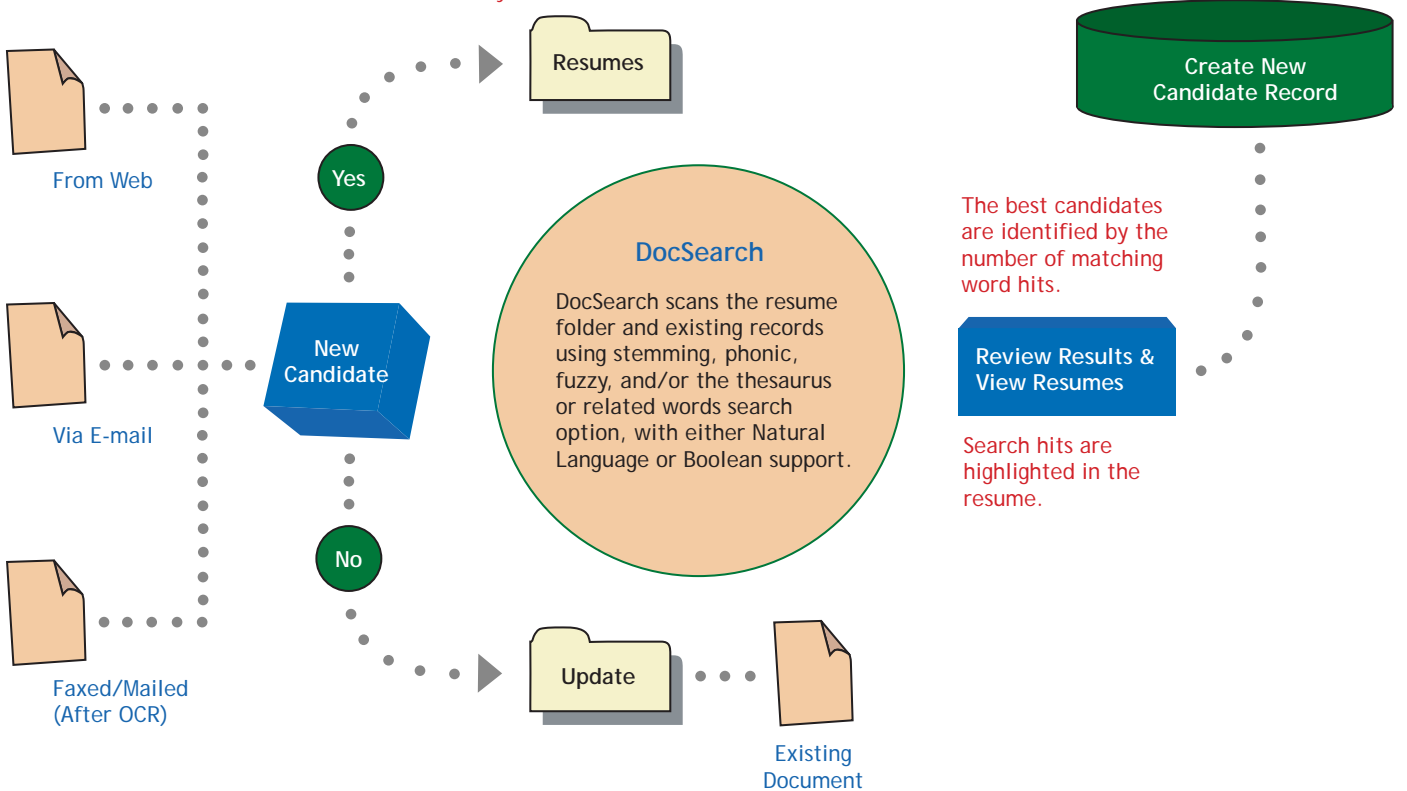
Imagine being able to search thousands of resumes in seconds. With powerful search options and the ability to search your results, you can quickly drill down to the perfect candidate.

You can also use DocSearch to manage and search resumes not in your database. Set up a "resume in-box" of unqualified resumes and keep your database clean. If your database searches don't turn up the right candidate, launch DocSearch and point it at your resume in-box.

Resume's can be acquired from many sources...

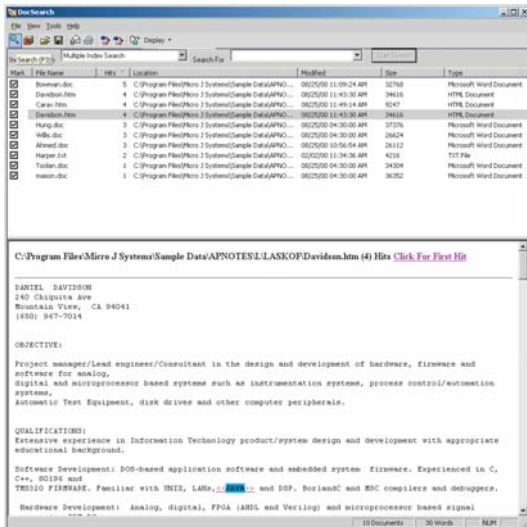
Filing unqualified resumes in a separate folder keeps your database clean.

## For PcHunter and Tempus Fugit



### Overview

DocSearch is a powerful keyword search engine that sits at the core of PcHunter and Tempus Fugit's resume and document management features. This component allows you to perform keyword searches of your files, quickly providing you with the results, while giving you the ability to send relevant documents to your database to ease the flow of work. This powerful search engine is capable of searching megabytes of text in seconds.

### Search Types

Supports both Boolean and natural language searches. You can also use any combination of the following search options:

- **Stemming**  
Searches other grammatical forms of the words in your search request. For example, with stemming enabled a search for apply would also find applies.
- **Phonic**  
finds words that sound similar to words in your request, like Smith and Smythe.
- **Fuzzy**  
Searches through scanning and typographical errors. You can adjust the fuzziness based on the degree of misspellings you want to search.
- **WordNet Thesaurus/Related Words**  
Using the included WordNet concept network you can find synonyms of the words you are searching for.

### Centralized Administration

From the Index Manager, administrators can set up shared indexes of resumes, notes, and attached documents and make them accessible to everyone on the network. Administrators can also schedule automatic updates of the indexes, so they always stay current.

### Multi-Pane Viewer

Customize your workspace using the split-pane viewer. Your search results are shown in upper portion while the lower portion displays the document.
